The Gold Nugget Race Directors and Board are seeking volunteer Race Committee members for the positions outlined below. The GNT Race Committee is a volunteer group with each position requiring a minimum two-year commitment (ideally longer). The Race Committee meets monthly from October/November through May, and requires minimal work outside of the monthly meetings as required for the specific position.

The committee is comprised of 20 dedicated and fun volunteers who work with the Race Directors in planning and executing the annual GNT event. The committee does require work and commitment but the reward of being a part of this one-of-a-kind event and the fun had is incredible!

Venue Management & Logistic Lead for Bartlett Event Area

The Venue Management team coordinates all set-up, tear down and general oversight of the main event venue at Bartlett High School from Friday evening through Sunday evening of race weekend. This includes coordination with many of the race committee (RC) leads and Race Directors (RDs).

This venue management team leads the venue layout and set-up, coordinating needs for set-up and logistics, overseeing set-up of volunteers and booster groups throughout the weekend, and coordinating tear-down efforts after the event.

The position works closely with the Race Directors and other committee members on planning for volunteers, supplies, timelines/schedules, and other logistics as needed. Over 100 booster group members and volunteers assist over various shifts from Saturday set-up to tear-down on Sunday.

This position can also be a co-lead position if one wanted to do it with a friend or family member.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Working with RD's to create a map of the layout of the main event area (T1, vendors, tents, traffic and pedestrian flow).
- Identifying supplies and equipment needed for the event area at Bartlett High School.
- Overseeing all venue management and set-up of volunteers and booster groups overseen by the Venue Management Race Committee Lead (or co-leads) in coordination with the T1 leads.
- Assisting with other logistics coordination for other areas of the event as appropriate for related set-up and tear-down activities.
- Marking the event venue in advance of set-up to ensure all vendors and equipment locations are noted.
- Hanging signs and banners, setting up tents, moving heavy equipment, and other set-up activities.

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- Overseeing and leading venue set-up, management and tear-down volunteers and booster groups.
- Being onsite:
 - Friday evening to mark initial layout of T1 (this is optional but is helpful in prepping for Saturday)
 - Saturday set-up and bike drop off ~7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. during event set-up and bike drop off
 - Race day ~5:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

It requires heavy lifting, coordinating race partners/vendors, managing volunteers, and attending race committee meetings and other planning meetings as necessary.

The GNT Race Committee meets monthly from October/November through May. Meetings are typically 1.5-2 hours and held in-person and virtually. The event typically takes place on the weekend directly preceding Mother's Day, with mandatory bike drop off on Saturday and the race on Sunday.

Transition 2 (T2) Lead

Transition 2 (T2) is located just east of the JBER/Arctic Valley Golf Course, where racers transition from the bike to the run portion of the race. The T2 Lead(s) coordinate T2 set-up on race day morning, manage all the T2 volunteers and activities during the race, facilitate T2 breakdown/clean-up and assist in returning all items back to Bartlett High School.

The position works closely with the Race Directors and other committee members on planning for volunteers, supplies, timelines/schedules, and other logistics as needed. 40-50 volunteers and booster club(s) assist in T2 over multiple shifts from set-up to tear down on race day).

All T2 volunteers are overseen by the T2 Race Committee Lead or Co-Leads. Historically the event has had one lead; co-leads may be used to spread out duties so that each person is afforded significant break times throughout the day.

Race day of is fast-paced, energetic, and fun. It requires taking bikes from racers upon their arrival into T2 and loading them into trucks for transport back to Bartlett High School. It also requires assuring racers are given their gear bags, water is readily available for racers and volunteers, and coordinating with race partners at T2 including the bike transport provider, medical team, communications team, and others.

It requires heavy lifting, coordinating race partners/vendors, managing volunteers, and attending race committee meetings and other planning meetings as necessary. Must have a valid driver's license and be willing/able to drive a U-Haul truck to transport supplies to/from Bartlett High School and T2.

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
